Grace Chapel, led by Pastor Steve Berger, has worked in the Dominican Republic for several years through the SCORE baseball/evangelism ministry. Plans for the construction of an orphanage in San Pedro de Macoris were underway when Josiah Berger, the son of Steve and his wife Sarah, unexpectedly went to Heaven on his 19th birthday on August 14, 2009. As a result, orphanage construction leaders felt led to name the home Josiah's House in his memory. Just weeks after Josiah's passing, they presented the idea to the Bergers who tearfully and joyfully accepted the gift in honor of their son. Josiah's life on earth aptly reflected a passion and love for God as well as a heart for underprivileged children in Spanish-speaking nations.
